

PHA HALL OF FAME AWARD RECOMMENDATION OUTLINE

NOMINATION RECOMMENDATION REQUIREMENTS

1. The following format is an outline to be used as a reference in preparing a resume. Additional topics or items associated with a candidate should also be included on the resume. The following is not an application form.
2. Hall of Fame inductees are selected by the Hall of Fame members based on the candidates' character and their dedication and contribution to, and love of, the motor sport of automobile Hill Climbing.
3. The candidate must present a strong moral character and demonstrate the levelheaded, cheerful camaraderie that sets hill climbers apart from most competitors in other motor sports. We look for a strong competitive nature controlled by a level head and sportsman-like attitude.
4. A limit of two inductees has been set by the committee. The number of inductees is to be evaluated by the committee and set annually.
5. In evaluation of the inductees, two categories must be considered.
 - a. One candidate must be evaluated primarily on a driving performance basis and time involved in hill climbing.
 - b. One candidate will be evaluated primarily on long time service; driving experience is desirable but not mandatory.
6. All candidates must meet the character and moral requirements outlined in 2 & 3 above.
7. Applications must be submitted by September 30 with a decision meeting of members no later than October 15.
8. Verbal recommendations made to Hall of Fame members or verbal or written recommendations submitted from the floor on the day of the meeting will not be accepted.
9. Nominations that are not accepted the year they are submitted will not automatically be reconsidered the following year. They will, however, be archived for future reference by the committee. Candidates can be resubmitted annually. An updated nomination resume must be submitted each year.
