This car was driven by Jim Ladd to an FTD win at the 1962 Weatherly Hill Climb (2nd event) and the 1962 Duryea Hill Climb!!

The car was sold at Bonhams for \$335,500.

It is one of the earliest left hand drive E-Types.

Spring Hershey, April 7-8: First A Production (Tom Robinson beat him for FTD)

Duryea, June 9-10: First A Production and FTD (fastest overall)

Giant's Despair, July 27-28: First A Production (John Meyer beat him for FTD)

Hyner View, October 27-28: First A Production and FTD

Spring Springtown, April 21: First A Production (George Wintersteen beat him for FTD)

Weatherly, October 13-14: First A Production and FTD

Fall Pocono, September 29-30: First A Production and FTD

Duryea, June 8-9: First A Production

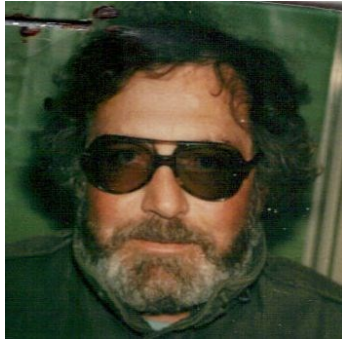


WHO IS IT?

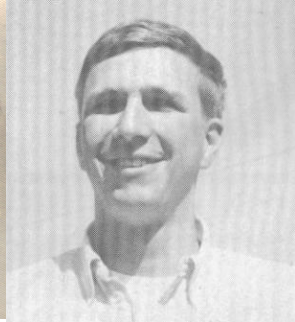
